The STEP experience is about learning through adventure! These experiences teach participants to work as group members- solving problems, sharing tasks and work assignments, and taking responsibility for each others' safety. Integrated into the STEP program are times of discussion, discovery, and goal-setting. This trip can be the catalyst that effects positive change in the youth of Allegany County.

1st STEP is a four-day adventure available to participants entering 6th – 8th grade. Activities include, Ropes Course, Climbing Wall, Swimming Pool, and Hiking the Finger Lakes Trail.

STEP is a ten-day adventure available to participants entering into 9th -12th grade. Activities include, Ropes Course, Rock Climbing, Hiking, and Canoeing in the Adirondacks.
